

MOVE PROJECT

The project seeks to prevent sexually transmitted and blood-borne infections for people aged 14 to 35 in Montreal. Move aims to promote safer sex practices and to mitigate systemic barriers to sexual health services for Afro-descendant persons, taking into account the realities of sexuality and gender diversity communities.

BELIEFS AND SEXUALITY

This workshop introduces sexuality in a global perspective while discussing its six dimensions. It also addresses several myths and facts about sexuality while looking into several stereotypical beliefs about HIV and STBBIs.

The workshop will allow participants to reflect on the positive and negative portrayals about STBBIs and HIV in the media.

PROTECTION AND SCREENING

This workshop tends to enhance the participants' knowledge on the risk factors related to STBBIs transmission and the proper usage of protection methods. With the intent to improve their sexual health, this meeting also demystifies the STBBIs screening process.

HIV focused version: Focused on the different types of HIV transmission and briefly explores other STBBIs.

STBBIs broader version: Addresses various types of STBBIs in general terms

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
