The Entourage project aims to prevent sexual exploitation and human trafficking among people aged 12 to 25 across the province of Quebec.

75 to 120 min / workshop

WORKSHOPS

DESCRIPTIONS

Intimacy & Seduction (new)

The workshop explores stereotypes and gender representation in virtual spaces, especially dating apps. It helps young people understand how these norms shape sexuality and encourages a more critical view of the expectations and self-images they encounter and share online.

Sexual Consent

The workshop allows young people to understand the legal aspects of sexual consent as well as its daily application. Whether in a real or virtual context, participants will be able to affirm their consent and manage rejection without violence.

Equal Relationships & Violence

This encounter discusses the importance of equal love relationships. It leads participants to question themselves about the components of a violence-free relationship so that they develop their ability to assert their needs and their limits in their interpersonal connections.

Dynamics & Exploitation

Through the workshop, participants will be able to understand the differences between sex work, sexual exploitation and human trafficking. They will also be able to understand the coaxing cycle of sexual exploitation in order to recognize the warning signs.
