Satellite is a sexual exploitation prevention project that aims to promote equal and consensual relationships among young people aged 12 to 25.

### DESCRIPTIONS

#### Intimacy & Sexuality

This session explores the various aspects of sexuality, as well as the myths and gender roles surrounding it. Participants will learn how to assert themselves effectively in their intimate relationships, regardless of stereotypes and societal norms regarding sexuality.

#### Equal Romantic Relationships

The goal of this session is to encourage participants to reflect on the attitudes and values associated with egalitarian romantic relationships. It provides an opportunity to explore topics such as jealousy, control, respect, reciprocity, and conflict resolution.

#### Sexual Consent

This session helps participants understand the legal aspects of consent in romantic and sexual relationships. Young people will explore the importance of respecting consent and asserting themselves in intimate situations, as well as debunking myths related to sexual assault.

#### Power Dynamics

This session explores how power dynamics manifest themselves in rape culture. Participants will gain a better understanding of the issues surrounding sexual exploitation (for both victims and pimps) and how it differs from sex work.
